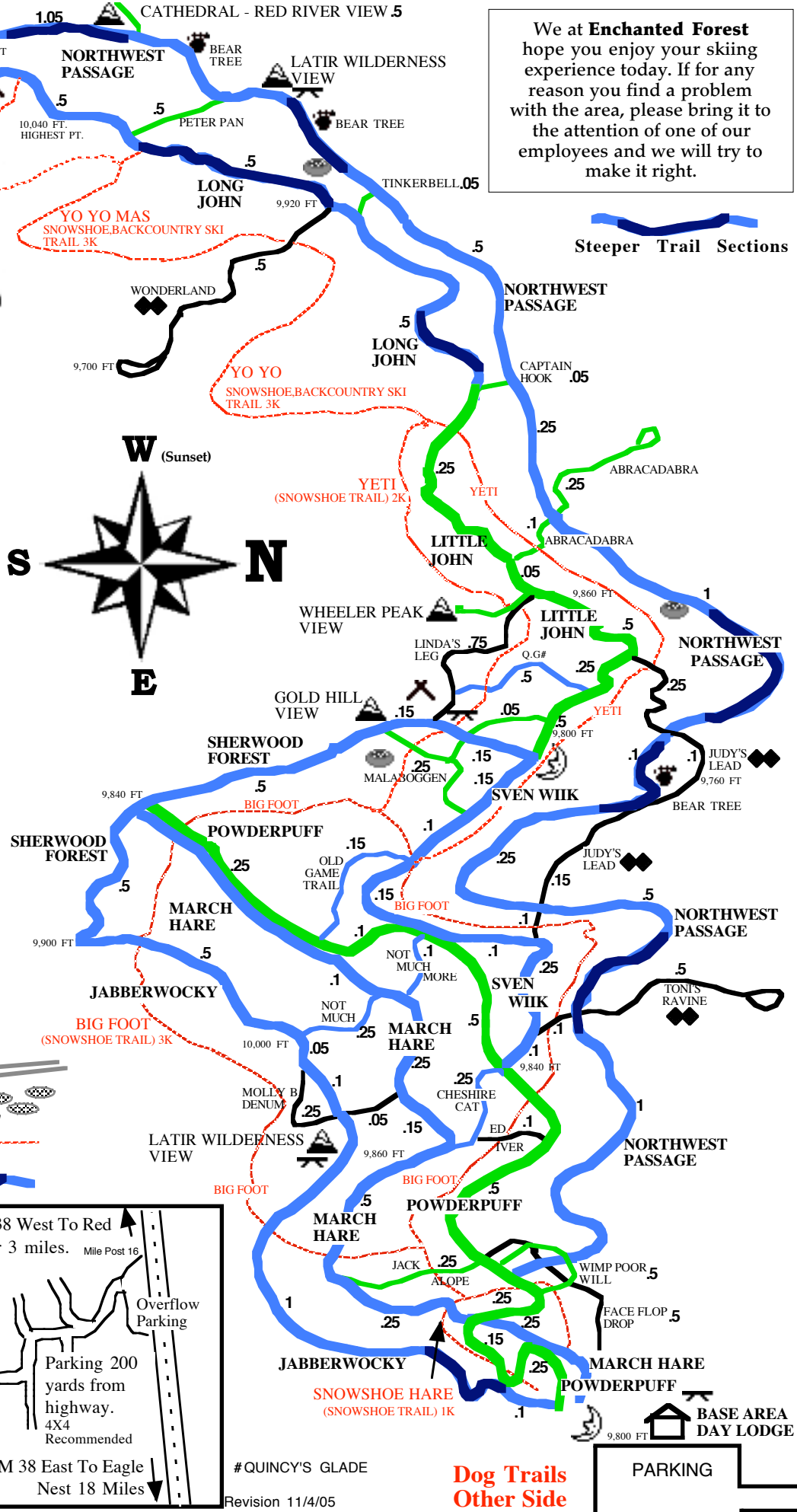

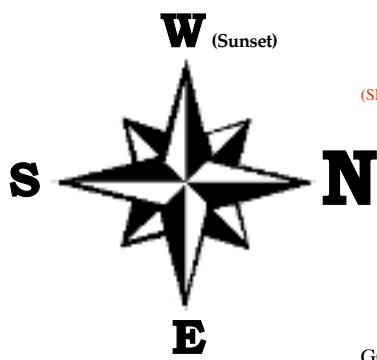
- Trails are marked but you should always carry a trail map. Stay on trails. It is easy to become disoriented even on marked and groomed trails.
- **Be cautious:** Your safety and the safety of others is affected by your common sense.
- **Conditions** vary greatly and grooming may not prevent ice, bare spots, falling trees, obstacles and inclement weather.
- **Grooming machines** and personnel may be on trails at anytime.
- **Our courtesy patrol** cannot cover all trails all day. Do not ski alone.
- **The New Mexico Skier Safety Act** recognizes that there are inherent risks in the sport of skiing. All skiers should be aware of these risks and should conduct themselves carefully and within the limits of their ability.

Always ask about local conditions, highlights and obstacles not on this map.

Distances between intersections are rounded up in kilometers.
